







# Ecosystem engineering

the "creation, modification and maintenance of habitats by organisms" (Gutiérrez *et al.* 2003).

## Ecosystem engineers

organisms that create, modify or maintain habitats in biotic and abiotic materials that, directly or indirectly, modulate the availability of resources to other species (Jones *et al.* 1994; 1997)
